(U) Declassification Efforts Currently Underway within the IC (U) July 2022

(U) Central Intelligence Agency (CIA)
The CIA maintains a steady investment in the development and refinement of next generation information management (NGIM) systems to improve the Agency's declassification process. In FY 2021, the CIA's budget for this effort is 2022, CIA requested for NGIM systems. For FY 2023, CIA is requesting for NGIM systems, no change from the FY 2022 level of funding.
(U) National Security Agency (NSA)
(U NSA utilizes three types of declassification: automatic, systematic, and mandatory.
NSA uses an Electronic Records Management system to capture permanent electronic records. An improved declassification module was developed to identify equities to automate the declassification process within the system and is in the final stages of testing, pending implementation in FY 2023. The new module will not automatically declassify records, but it will make recommendations based on rules developed from the NSA Declassification Guide, approved by the Information System Security Officer, and will remove personally identifiable information, which will speed up the process of declassification. NSA remains committed to an annual budget of approximately which continues in FY 2023.

(U) Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA)
In FY 2021, DIA created an Information Management and Compliance Office that brought the government information services and declassification missions together in one organization to achieve greater efficiency. This organization reports to the Office of the Chief of Staff at DIA.
(U) National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA)
The NGA declassification program's annual operating budget is approximately and includes funds to support declassification modernization.

(U) Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI)

The ODNI is working with the CIA in their development of new declassification tools and to gain access to their new case management system (and all additional IT advances that come with it, now and in the future) to replace its current CIA Automated Declassification and Release Environment (CADRE) system. ODNI requested an additional in FY 2023 above the FY 2022 request.
