## **3** SECTION 1. REPORT ON DEATH OF JAMAL KHASHOGGI.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after the
5 date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of National
6 Intelligence shall submit to Congress a report on the death
7 of Jamal Khashoggi. Such report shall include identifica8 tion of those who carried out, participated in, ordered, or

were otherwise complicit in or responsible for the death
 of Jamal Khashoggi.

3 (b) FORM.—The report submitted under subsection4 (a) shall be submitted in unclassified form.
