3 SECTION 1. USE OF COUNTY FUNDS.

- 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 302 of the Secure Rural
- 5 Schools and Community Self-Determination Act of 2000
- 6 (16 U.S.C. 7142) is amended—
- 7 (1) in subsection (a)—

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1	(A) in paragraph (2), by redesignating
2	subparagraphs (A) and (B) as clauses (i) and
3	(ii), respectively, and indenting appropriately;
4	(B) in paragraph (3), by striking "para-
5	graph (2)" and inserting "subparagraph (B)";
6	(C) by redesignating paragraphs (1)
7	through (4) as subparagraphs (A) through (D),
8	respectively, and indenting appropriately;
9	(D) in the matter preceding subparagraph
10	(A) (as so redesignated), by striking "A partici-
11	pating" and inserting the following:
12	"(1) IN GENERAL.—A participating"; and
13	(E) by adding at the end the following:
14	"(2) Prohibition.—In accordance with section
15	1913 of title 18, United States Code, county funds
16	shall not be used for—
17	"(A) any expense relating to lobbying; or
18	"(B) any activity the purpose of which is
19	to influence a State or Federal lawmaker."; and
20	(2) by adding at the end the following:
21	"(c) Rulemaking.—
22	"(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days
23	after the date of enactment of this subsection, the
24	Chief of the Forest Service, in coordination with the
25	Director of the Bureau of Land Management, shall

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promulgate regulations providing guidance for par ticipating counties on the appropriate use of county
 funds.

4 "(2) PUBLICATION.—The Chief of the Forest
5 Service and the Director of the Bureau of Land
6 Management shall publish the guidance under para7 graph (1) on a publicly available website of the For8 est Service and the Bureau of Land Management,
9 respectively.".

(b) REPORTS.—Section 303 of the Secure Rural
Schools and Community Self-Determination Act of 2000
(16 U.S.C. 7143) is amended by adding at the end the
following:

14 "(c) SUMMARY REPORTS.—

15 "(1) IN GENERAL.—Each participating county
16 shall submit to the Secretary concerned an annual
17 report summarizing the certification submitted
18 under subsection (a) for the relevant year, including
19 a brief description of how the participating county
20 used county funds during the year covered by the re21 port.

"(2) SUBMISSION.—A participating county shall
submit a report under paragraph (1) at such time,
in such manner, and containing such information as
the Secretary concerned may require.

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"(3) PUBLIC AVAILABILITY.—The Secretary
 concerned shall make each report submitted under
 paragraph (1) publicly available online in a machine readable format.".
