## OREGON IMPACTS

On July 4, 2025, congressional Republicans and Trump enacted the largest health care cuts in history, slashing over \$1 trillion from Medicaid and the Affordable Care Act (ACA). Already, Oregon hospitals and clinics are closing, Oregonians are being laid off and losing insurance coverage, and the state is facing impossible budget constraints. New moms, children, rural communities, people with disabilities, and working families are feeling the strain. **Senator Wyden is fighting back.**

**Why it matters:** The closures reduce access to same-day, walk-in care for illnesses and injuries, increasing pressure on emergency departments and limiting care options.

**Went Into Effect:** October 4, 2025


#### Long-Term Care Hospital Closure Takes Care Options Away from Vulnerable Patients

**Where:** Portland, OR - Vibra Specialty Hospital


**Why it matters:** The closure eliminates 310 jobs and specialized care for patients with complex medical needs requiring extended hospitalization, forcing patients to seek care farther from home.

**Went Into Effect:** February 1, 2026
