A BILL

To amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act relating to grants for beach monitoring, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Beaches Environ-
- 5 mental Assessment and Coastal Health Act of 2025" or
- 6 the "BEACH Act of 2025".

1	SEC. 2. COASTAL RECREATION WATER QUALITY MONI-
2	TORING AND NOTIFICATION.
3	(a) Program Development and Implementation
4	Grants.—Section 406 of the Federal Water Pollution
5	Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1346) is amended—
6	(1) in subsection (b)—
7	(A) in paragraph (1)—
8	(i) by inserting ", including nearby
9	shallow upstream waters," after "coastal
10	recreation waters"; and
11	(ii) by inserting "or present on" after
12	"adjacent to";
13	(B) in paragraph (3)(A)—
14	(i) in clause (i), by striking "and" at
15	the end;
16	(ii) by redesignating clause (ii) as
17	clause (iii); and
18	(iii) by inserting after clause (i) the
19	following:
20	"(ii) in the case of a State that uses
21	such grant to identify specific sources of
22	contamination pursuant to paragraph (5),
23	any data relating to such identified sources
24	of contamination; and"; and
25	(C) by adding at the end the following:

1	"(5) IDENTIFICATION OF SPECIFIC SOURCES OF
2	CONTAMINATION.—A State or local government re-
3	ceiving a grant under this subsection may use such
4	grant to identify specific sources of contamination
5	for coastal recreation waters, including nearby shal-
6	low upstream waters, adjacent to or present on
7	beaches or similar points of access that are used by
8	the public.";
9	(2) in subsection $(g)(1)$ —
10	(A) by inserting ", including nearby shal-
11	low upstream waters," after "coastal recreation
12	waters"; and
13	(B) by inserting "or present on" after "ad-
14	jacent to"; and
15	(3) in subsection (i), by striking "\$30,000,000
16	for each of fiscal years 2001 through 2005" and in-
17	serting "\$30,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2025
18	through 2029".
19	(b) Authorization of Appropriations.—Section
20	8 of the Beaches Environmental Assessment and Coastal
21	Health Act of 2000 (Public Law 106–284; 114 Stat. 877)
22	is amended by striking "2001 through 2005" and insert-
23	ing "2025 through 2029".

1 SEC. 3. GUIDANCE.

2 In providing guidance to States and local govern-

- 3 ments receiving grants under section 406 of the Federal
- 4 Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1346), the Ad-
- 5 ministrator of the Environmental Protection Agency shall
- 6 ensure that such guidance reflects innovations in testing
- 7 technologies for water contamination.
